Objectives and investment policy

The Fund seeks an increase of the value of your investment and a positive return in both up and down markets (absolute return) by focusing on equity markets. The Fund has a long-short investment strategy, which attempts to capture profits in all market cycles. The Fund has no reference benchmark.

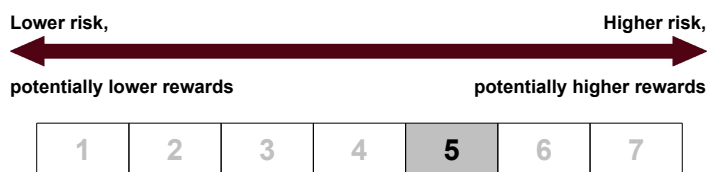
The Fund mainly invests in a portfolio of stocks issued by companies that derive the whole or a substantial proportion of their income from banking, financial services and insurance. The Fund may also invest in UCITS, UCIs, Exchange Traded Funds and eligible financial derivative instruments.

The Fund may use financial derivative instruments to protect its portfolio against market or currency fluctuations. Currency risks may be hedged entirely or partially against the Euro. The Fund may also use financial derivatives to reduce other risks or to produce more revenues.

The Fund is open-ended. You may redeem shares of the Fund on any Luxembourg business day.

The Share Class makes no dividend payment.

Risk and reward profile

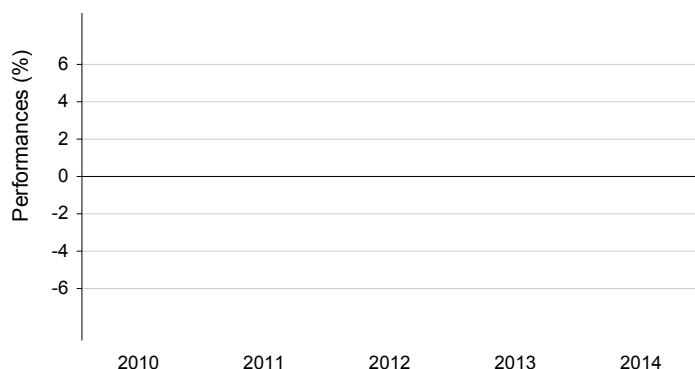
